Please find hereby some tips and useful information about your travel arrangements regarding airport transfers and public transportation in Budapest.

## Public transportation

Public transport is very good in Budapest, it is worth using it when arriving in the city and within the city.

### Airport shuttle services: 100E Airport Express

Should you opt for flying, you shall arrive to Liszt Ferenc International Airport in Budapest. Please note that most service providers and their employees speak some level of English, however, if you encounter any difficulties, you may ask for help from other passengers or pedestrians.



100E Airport Express shuttle bus is providing a direct, convenient, economical and fast connection between Liszt Ferenc International Airport and Budapest city centre.

The buses run around the clock, every 7-10 minutes during the day and every 15-30 minutes early morning and late evening. You can [check the timetable here](#).

The Airport shuttle bus single ticket is 2 200 HUF.

### Budapest GO app

The easiest way to get around in Budapest (even from and back to the airport or one of the bus or railway stations) is to download the **Budapest GO** application to your mobile phone which offers services in English as well and you may also make in-app purchases for tickets. ### Public transport prices

Note: citizens of EU, EEA member states or Switzerland over 65 years of age can travel free of charge on public transport in Hungary on presentation of an identity document.

### Budapest card

The Budapest Card is a physical card that you can pick up in the centre of Budapest.

## Taxis

### Főtaxi

Főtaxi, the taxi company with the longest traditions (founded 1913) in Hungary transports passengers between airport terminals and Budapest.



At the airport reservations can be made in person at the Főtaxi booths located at the exits of Terminals 2A and 2B. At the taxi ranks in front of the stands, taxis are continuously waiting for passengers.

Should you opt for travelling by railway or international bus service, you can also expect to find taxis waiting for passengers right outside of the railway or bus station.

In Hungary, the taxi decree regulates the price\* of taxis at a fixed tariff of 440 HUF/km (1,18 EUR/km), in addition to a one-off basic fee of 1100 HUF (2.95 EUR) and a waiting fee. A ride from the airport to the city centre should typically cost around 10800 HUF (28 EUR), depending on traffic conditions.

\*Prices include VAT. Prices indicated in EUR are subject to the prevailing HUF/EUR exchange rate.

Please note that most service providers and their employees speak some level of English, however, if you encounter any difficulties, you may ask for help from other passengers or pedestrians.

Please be aware of potentially exposing yourself to risks by using other, non-contracted taxi service providers soliciting at the terminal buildings.

Most taxis are now equipped with POS terminals to allow credit card payment, however, it is strongly suggested to check beforehand.

MiniBUD is the official airport shuttle service provider for Budapest Airport which operates minibuses, a sort of shared taxis. It is a direct transfer from the airport to a specified address in Budapest.
