The word "power". Exploration of our experiences and concepts

Duration: 2x 1h 45min

Goal of the workshop:

To make use of ANSE-Community diversity potential in order to explore the discourse of power of words Here and Now at Summer University.

Concept:

Exploring what people mean by power words, makes it easier to understand the dynamics if its usage. You can explore whether concept of the word has changed under the condition of uncertainty. Whether or how the accents moved? What people from the different cultures mean by it, what is common and what varies.

Depending on what is the notion of power words on this or that culture or person's mental map, further ways of work or accents at work may differ.

The exploration itself allows to expand the meaning and enrich the mental map of the participants.

During the workshop there will be reflection and exploration of the given topic: individually, in subgroups and plenary. Involvement of the right and left-brain hemispheres while working with visualization and symbolization.

Learning outcome:

Our perception of the usage of the concept of POWER and its various connotations in native and foreign languages and in different professional and cultural contexts. Experience of comparing language and mental maps of workshop participants and compiling a joint map of the identified diversity.
